## FIRST PARTY:

**Haldia Petrochemicals Limited (HPL)**, a company incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 and governed under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at Bengal Eco Intelligent Park, Tower-1, Block EM, Plot No. 3, Sector V, Salt Lake City, Kolkata – 700091, West Bengal, hereinafter referred to as "**HPL**", which term shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors, assigns, and administrators, acting through its duly authorized representative.

## SECOND PARTY:

**West Bengal Forest Development Corporation Limited (WBFDCCL)**, a Government of West Bengal enterprise incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, within the Forest Department, having its registered office at Aranya Bikash, 1st Floor, KB-19, Sector-III, Salt Lake City, Kolkata – 700106, West Bengal, hereinafter referred to as "**WBFDCCL**", which term shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors, assigns, and administrators, acting through its duly authorized representative.

## PREAMBLE

### WHEREAS:

WBFDCCL is a reputed government-owned organization with rich experience in forestry operations, afforestation, reclamation of wasteland, and promotion of sustainable eco-development programs, managed by experienced Forest Service officers.

HPL, a leading petrochemical company in India, has sought WBFDCCL's assistance in executing a comprehensive green belt development program within and around its premises at Haldia, West Bengal.

The afforestation activities enhance existing green belts, thereby building climate resilience.

WBFDCCL has agreed to undertake this assignment as a **Deposit Work** based on mutual terms.

## ARTICLE I: SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

- a. The Project entails:
  - ✓ **Creation and 3 years maintenance** of a new green belt area covering **17.80 hectares (2500 trees/ Ha)** and
  - ✓ **Restoration and 3 years maintenance** of an existing green belt area spanning **56 hectares (2500 trees/ Ha)**.
- b. The WBFDCCL will execute the creation and subsequent 3 years maintenance works of Green Belt adjacent to Main Plant inside Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. Over 17.80Ha. and Restoration of Existing Green Belt and 3 years maintenance of Green Belt at Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. Over 56 Ha. on lands of Haldia Petrochemicals Limited (the creation, restoration and maintenance of the Green Belt are hereunder collective referred to as the said "*Project*").
- c. As far as possible local, indigenous species will be selected for planting for restoration of the green belt area at Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd.



## ARTICLE II: FINANCIAL TERMS

- a. The total tentative cost of the Project is **Rs. 7,58,89,528** (Rupees Seven Crore Fifty-Eight Lakh Eighty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Eight only) as stated in Annexure-1.
- b. Based on the estimated cost as provided hereinabove, HPL has agreed to pay an advance amount of 10% of the estimated cost of the Project as set forth by Wbfdcl (amounting to **Rs 75,88,952.80 only Rupees Seventy-Five Lakhs Eighty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Two and Paise Eighty Only**) as an expression of its interest to participate in the Project. 40% payment of the fund to be released to Wbfdcl after finalisation of the L1 bid and before issuance of Work Order. Wbfdcl shall initiate the tender process only after signing of MoU and after release of the said Advance amount to the Wbfdcl.
- c. HPL shall pay the said advance of 10% in the following bank account of Wbfdcl:

- d. The final payment to Wbfdcl shall be made by HPL on the basis of the actual quantity, and as per the final L1 bid amount, and subject to the actual work executed, as verified during joint field inspections conducted by representatives of both HPL and Wbfdcl.
- e. Wbfdcl shall be responsible for engaging the contractor and finalising the L1 bidder through a transparent and competitive open e-tender process, in strict compliance with the prevailing financial norms and procedures of the Government of West Bengal. Contractor shall have to ensure the engagement of job card holders as unskilled workers for execution of awarded work as per guidelines of "Karmashree Scheme".
- f. Goods & Service Tax (GST), as applicable for related works will be added to the estimate by the Wbfdcl authorities.
- g. A **12.5% Administrative Charge plus applicable GST** shall be levied on the total estimates by Wbfdcl.
- h. Any escalation in the cost of labour arising due to revisions in minimum wage rates notified by the Labour Commissioner, Government of West Bengal, from time-to-time, shall be borne by Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. (HPL). Additionally, any increase in the cost of materials on account of revisions in the applicable Schedule of Rates (SoR) shall also be the responsibility of HPL. Wbfdcl shall not be held liable for any such escalations beyond the agreed contractual terms.
- i. The subsequent release of funds by Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. (HPL) to West Bengal Forest Development Corporation Ltd. (Wbfdcl) shall be based on the actual



quantum of work executed by Wbfdcl in different phases. Upon intimation from Wbfdcl regarding completion of a specific phase of work, authorised officials of HPL shall attend the joint inspection within **30 (thirty) days** of such notification. Following the completion of joint inspection and submission of the Proforma Invoice by Wbfdcl, HPL shall ensure release of payment within **60 (sixty) days**.

- j. Each tranche of fund release shall be contingent upon submission of a "Utilisation Certificate" by Wbfdcl corresponding to the previously released funds. The quality and quantity of the executed works shall be verified by HPL only during the joint inspections. Execution of the work, including methodology, deployment, and supervision, shall be carried out by Wbfdcl as per its internal systems and procedures.

### **ARTICLE III: IMPLEMENTATION FRAMEWORK**

- a. Wbfdcl shall execute the project through its designated Divisions, Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs), registered Labour Cooperatives, or other government-approved agencies, as deemed appropriate. Additionally, Wbfdcl reserves the right to engage any other competent agency for execution of the work through an open tender process, as per its discretion and in accordance with applicable rules and procedures.
- b. The minimum wage rates as notified by the Government of West Bengal from time to time shall be strictly adhered to during the execution of the project.
- c. Any changes in the items of work, such as additions, deletions, or modifications to the estimate during the execution of the project, shall be taken into consideration upon submission of a revised work programme by Wbfdcl to HPL, and shall be implemented subject to mutual agreement between both parties.
- d. Procurement of materials, tendering procedures, engagement of Joint Forest Management Committee (JFMC) members, contractors or Labour Co-operative Societies, plantation practices, etc., shall be carried out by Wbfdcl as per its internal systems and procedures. HPL shall have no role in these processes, except for verification of the quality and quantity of work during the half-yearly joint inspections.
- e. As per the request of HPL authorities, the provision for watering of plants has been excluded from the estimates. Consequently, the full responsibility for ensuring timely and adequate watering of the seedlings throughout the project period shall lie with HPL, and Wbfdcl shall bear no responsibility or liability whatsoever in this regard.

### **ARTICLE IV: MONITORING & REPORTING**

There shall be a half-yearly joint inspection conducted by the authorised representatives of Wbfdcl and HPL. The Final Joint Inspection Report, duly countersigned by both parties, shall serve as the basis for determining the final payable amount for the completed works during the said financial year.



## ARTICLE V: SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- a. HPL shall provide Land free from all encroachments to Wbfdcl for implementing project.
- b. HPL shall provide suitable office-cum-store facilities and temporary accommodation near the project site for the executing and supervisory teams of Wbfdcl and its executing division(s), as afforestation works require continuous and close supervision.
- c. HPL shall ensure that the seedlings are not damaged by their staff, labourers, or cattle during the course of official or domestic activities. Concurrently, Wbfdcl shall undertake watch and ward responsibilities for the protection of nursery seedlings, plantation works, Soil Moisture Conservation and other afforestation activities. All staff or labourers authorised by the Executing Division(s) of Wbfdcl or its representatives shall be granted access to the HPL premises at any time, day, or night, as required for execution and supervision of the works. HPL shall be solely responsible for maintaining law and order within its premises. In the event of labour unrest or any law-and-order disturbance, Wbfdcl and its executing division(s) reserve the right to suspend or withdraw their activities until normalcy is restored.
- d. HPL shall, at its own cost, provide essential amenities including drinking water, labour sheds, and firefighting support at the work site, as and when required.

## ARTICLE VI: TERMINATION

This MoU shall be valid for the entire execution and maintenance period. However, the validity of the MoU can be extended till such period on mutually agreed terms. Either party may terminate this MoU with **three months' notice**, provided all outstanding obligations are settled.

## ARTICLE VII: FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be held liable for failure to perform due to circumstances beyond reasonable control such as natural disasters, war, pandemics, or civil unrest.

In the event that the completed plantation work is damaged due to fire, natural calamities, labour unrest, or adverse biotic interference, the matter shall be settled mutually between both parties. Wbfdcl shall not be held responsible for such unforeseen or uncontrollable events.

## ARTICLE VIII: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- a. Any disputes arising between the parties shall be resolved through a Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC) comprising four members — two nominated by the Managing Director, Wbfdcl, and two nominated by the competent authority of HPL.
- b. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the **High Court of Calcutta** only.
